Antonin “Tony” Aeck serves as chairman of architecture, interiors, planning and preservation firm Lord Aeck Sargent. With offices in Ann Arbor, Atlanta, Austin, Chapel Hill, Lexington and Washington, and projects dispersed throughout the U.S., Aeck has enjoyed an interesting and varied 30+ year practice. Although his main focus has been mainstream institutional and governmental projects, his experience includes such atypical commissions as the historic restoration of two Georgia capitols, a new national mosque for the nation of Nigeria, an anti-terrorism first-responder center for the U.S. Department of Defense and a sustainable transit station in suburban Beijing.
